•All parents have the right to request the following: • A teacher's professional qualifications, which includes: state qualifications, licensure, certification, waivers · A teacher's baccalaureate and /or graduate degree, fields of endorsement, previous teaching experience • A paraprofessional's qualifications • An assurance that their child's name, address, and telephone listing not be •released to military recruiters •All parents will receive information on the following: Their child's level of achievement in each of the state academic assessments Their option to request a transfer to another school within the district if their child •is the victim of a violent crime at school Their right to timely notification that their child has been assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who is not highly qualified


